<b>Reviewed phonic elements</b>	diphthong /oi/: variant vowels
<b>Story words</b>	silly, wrong
<b>Reviewed story words</b>	face, far, people
<b>New high-frequency word</b>	around
<b>Special considerations</b>	inflectional endings -ed, -ing, -s, -y; possessive 's; two-syllable decodable words

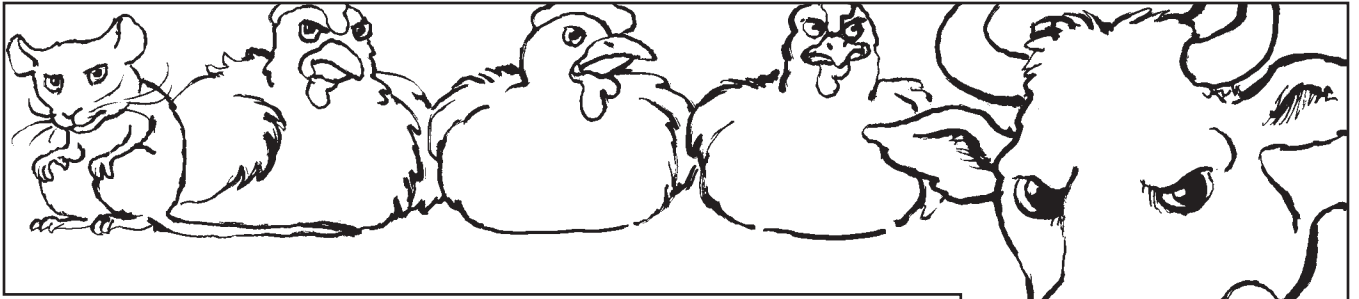
The people went from house to house

but no one found the clown's smile.



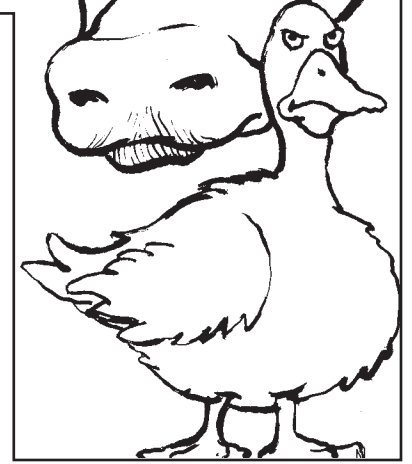

The hound growled and said no.

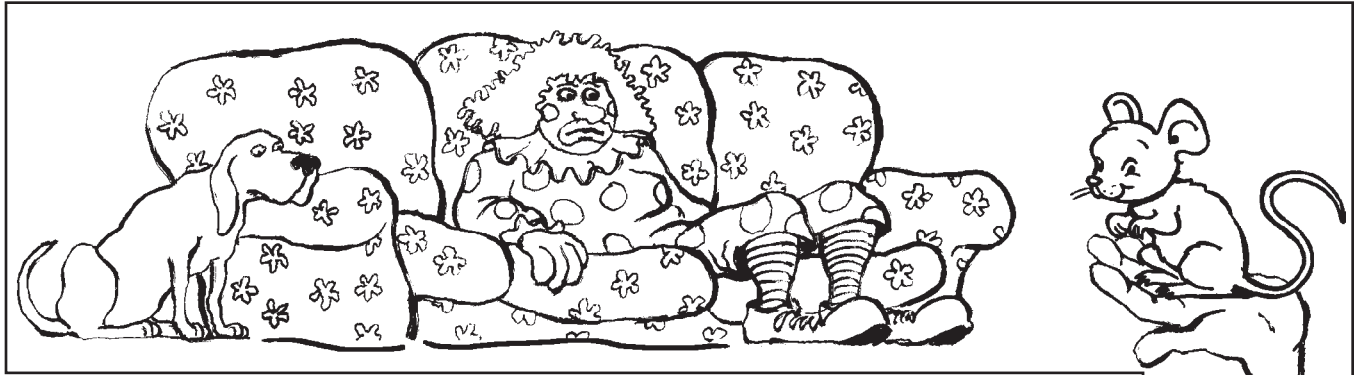




They asked the brown mouse

The clown's smile must come from inside the clown."

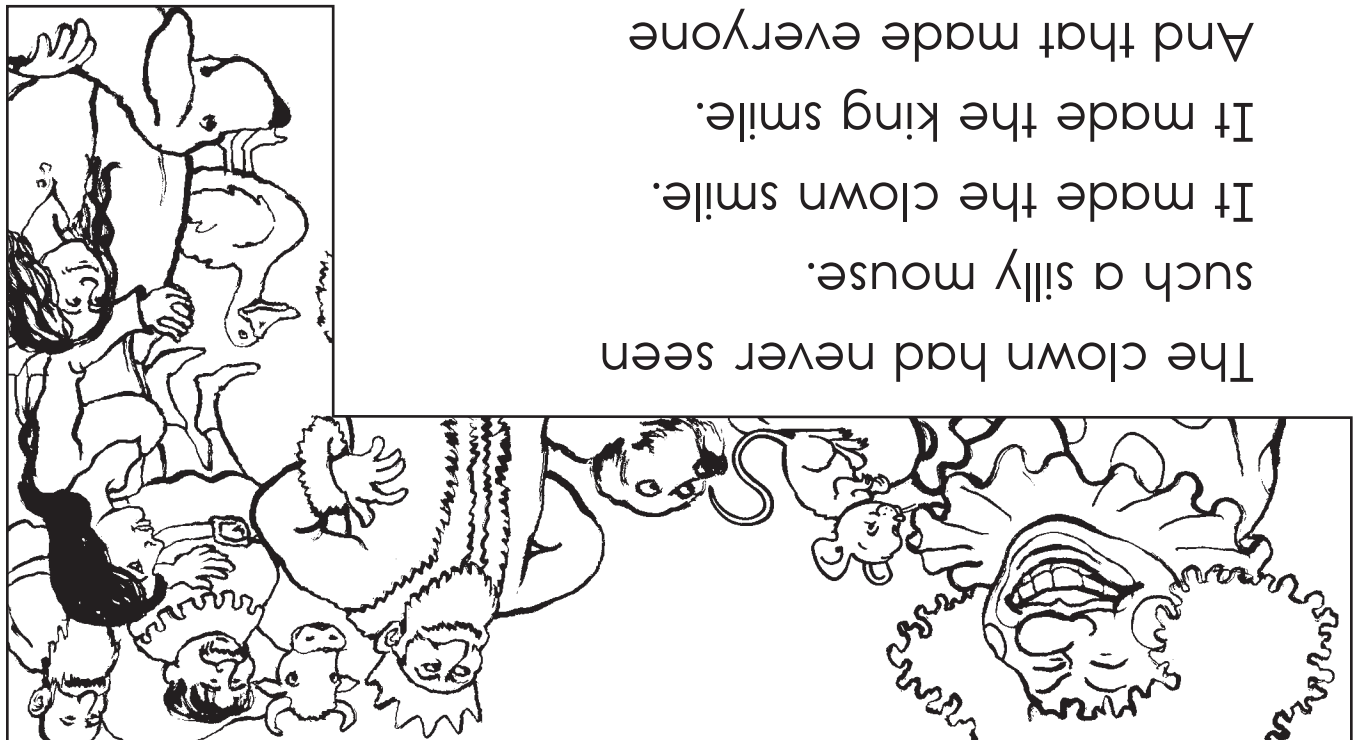


The people had to make the clown smile.
