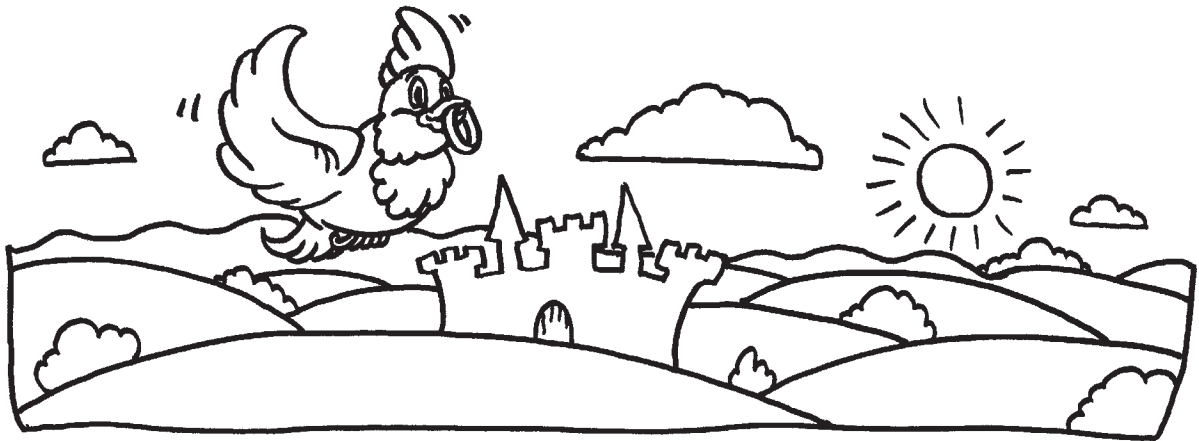

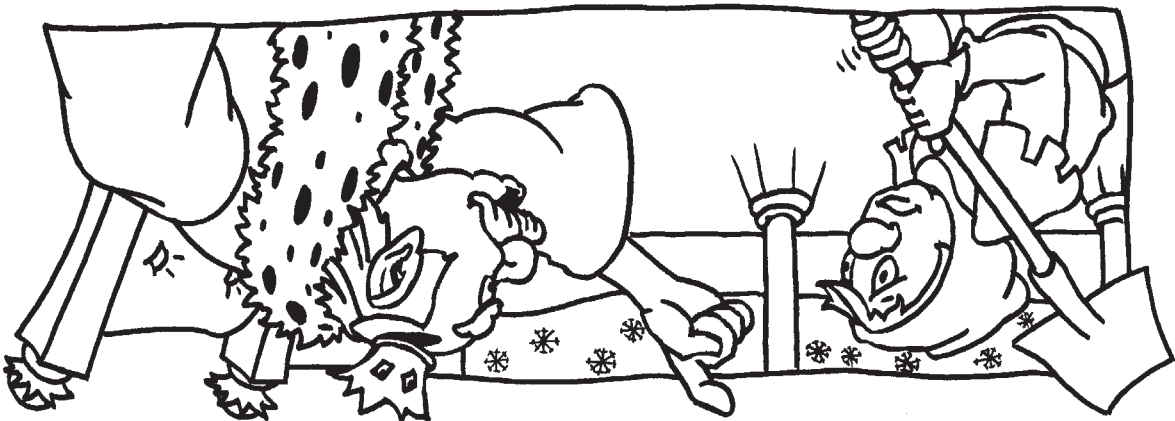
The king of Ding Dong

You must find my ring!”

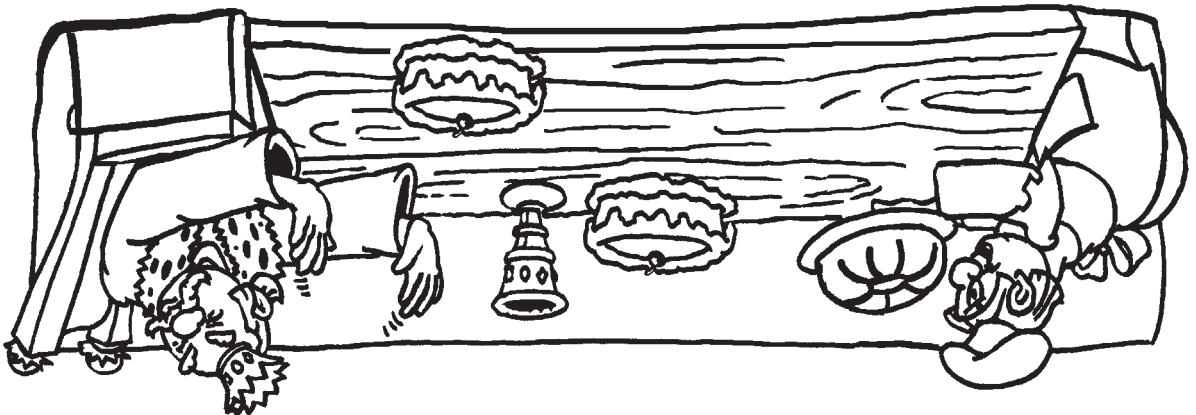


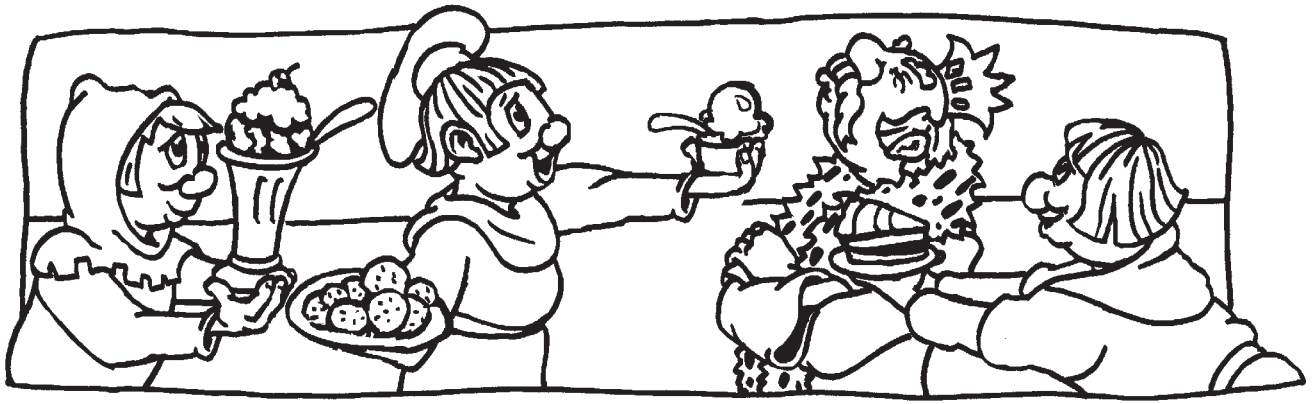


The king hired a gang of men

You must find my ring!” said the king.

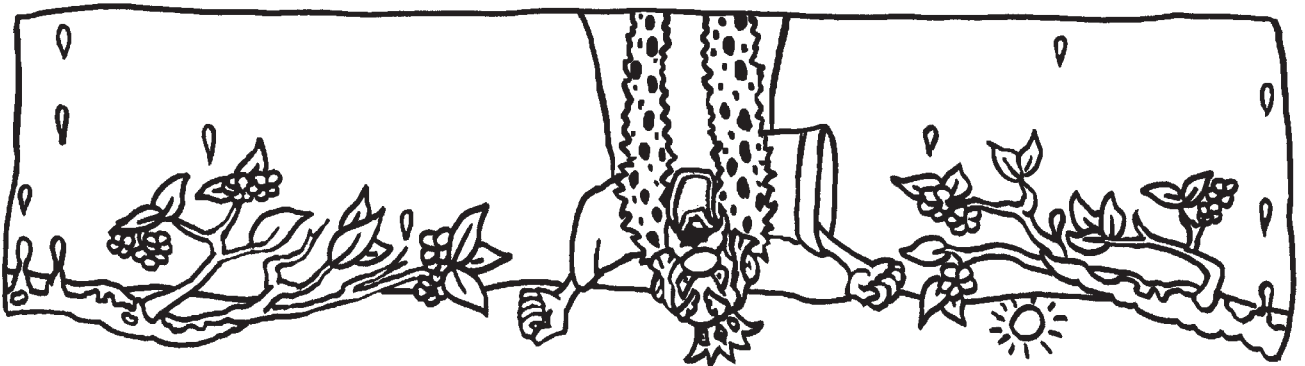
The king was sad.

sing a happy song,” he said.

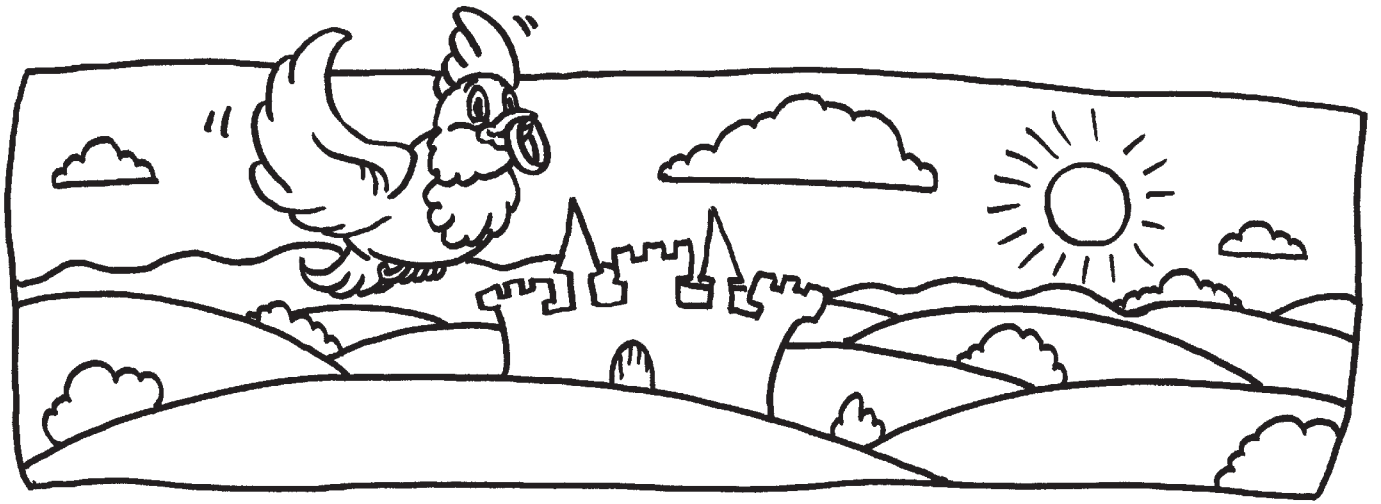




All the people in the kingdom

The king was still not happy.

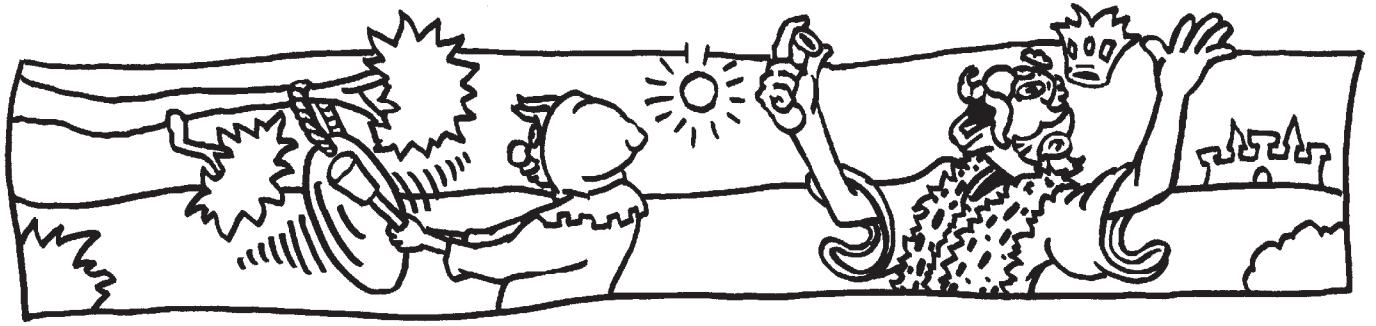




A robin looked down.
