

The king of Ding Dong looked at his hand. "Help!" he said. "I have lost my ring! I must have dropped it in the mud."





The king hired a gang of men to look for his ring. "Dig up all the mud in the kingdom. You must find my ring!" said the king.







A robin looked down. It saw a shape shining in a pile of mud. It was the king's ring. The robin picked up the ring.


