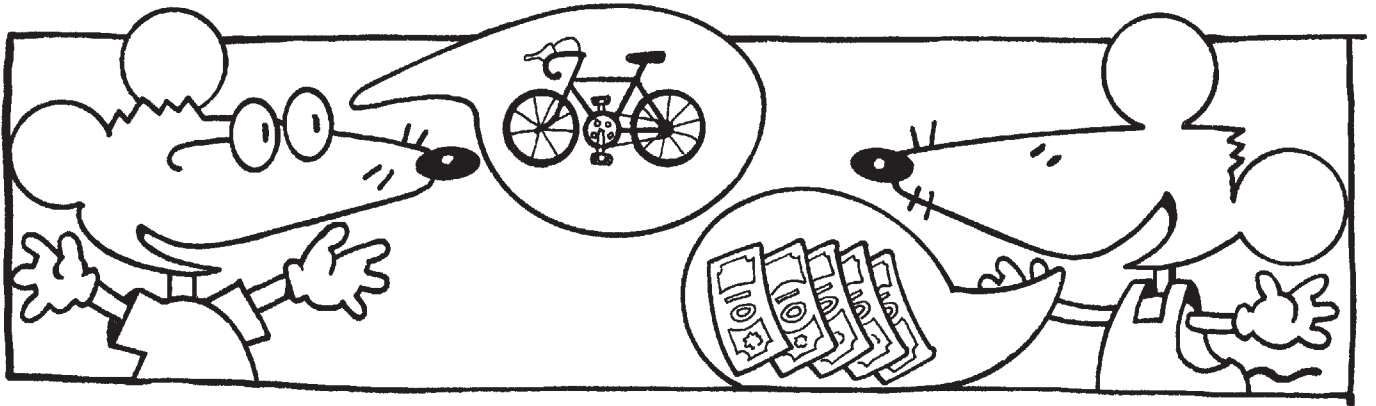
ELEMENTS USED IN THIS BOOK

Words with new phonic element	bike, dime, dine, fine, like, lime, Mike, nine, pile, quite, ride, ripe, side, site, smile, spike, time
Reviewed phonic elements	initial and final blends; VcE long /a/; VcE long /o/
Story words	dollar, hundred, ice, mice, money, nice, pick, slice
Reviewed story word	until
New high-frequency words	always, far, find
Special considerations	double consonants: plural ending -s; inflectional endings -ed, -ing;

They liked to smile.

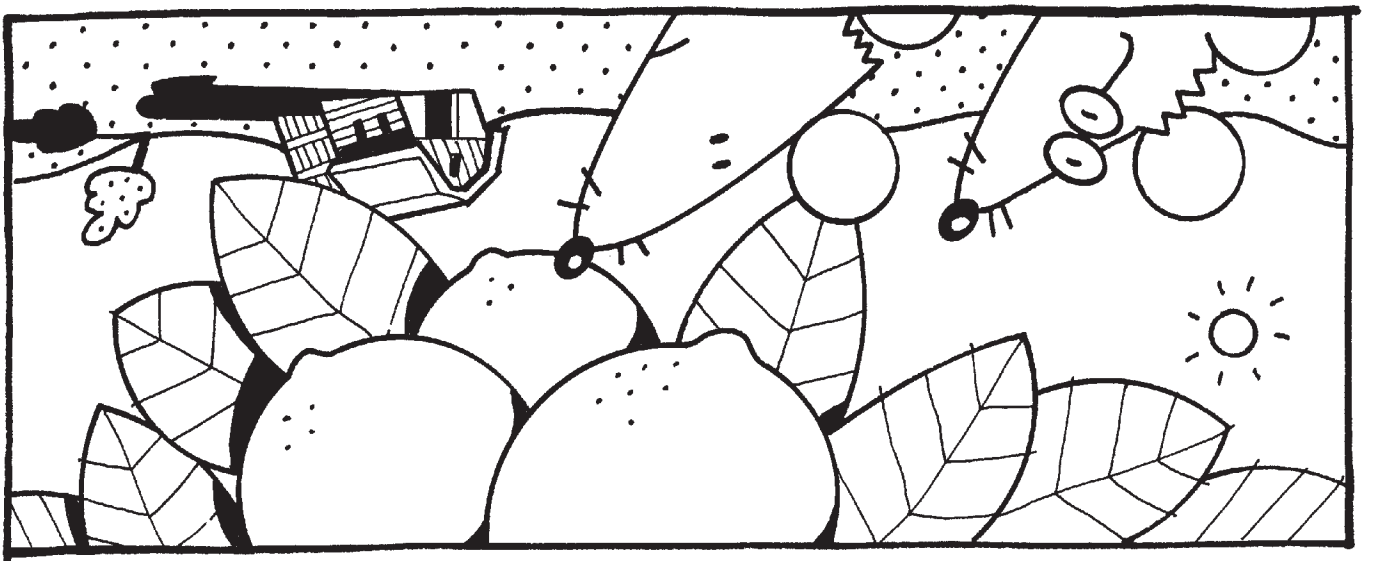
Mike asked Spike

And he wanted to dine in fine places.

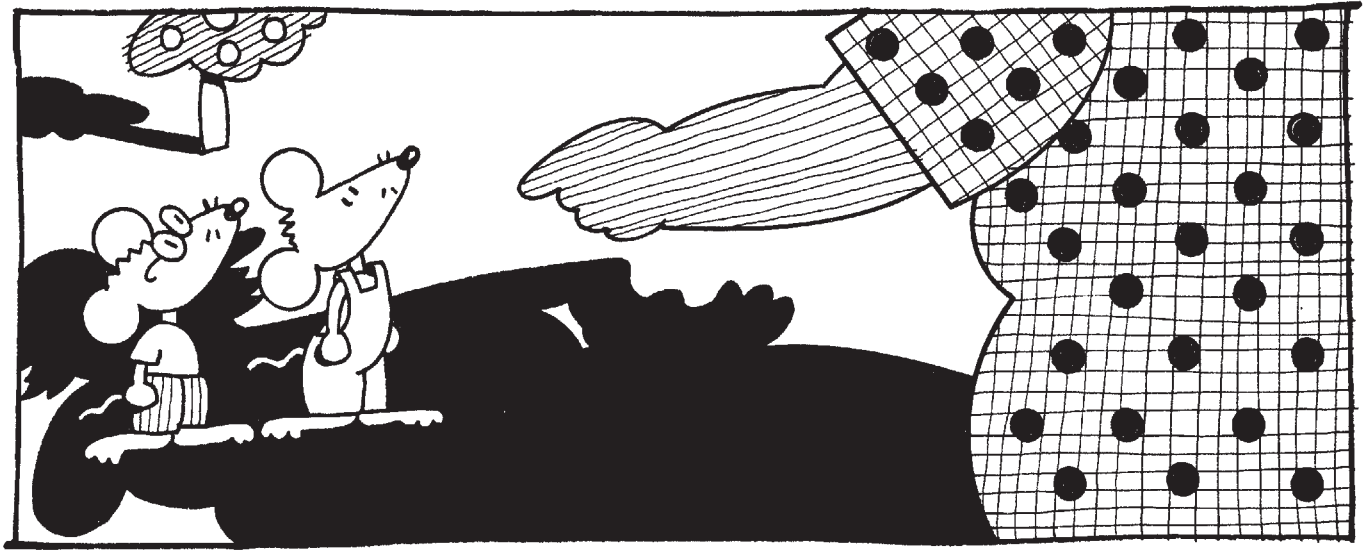




Mike said, "We will ride bikes on the trip.

on the slope of a hill.

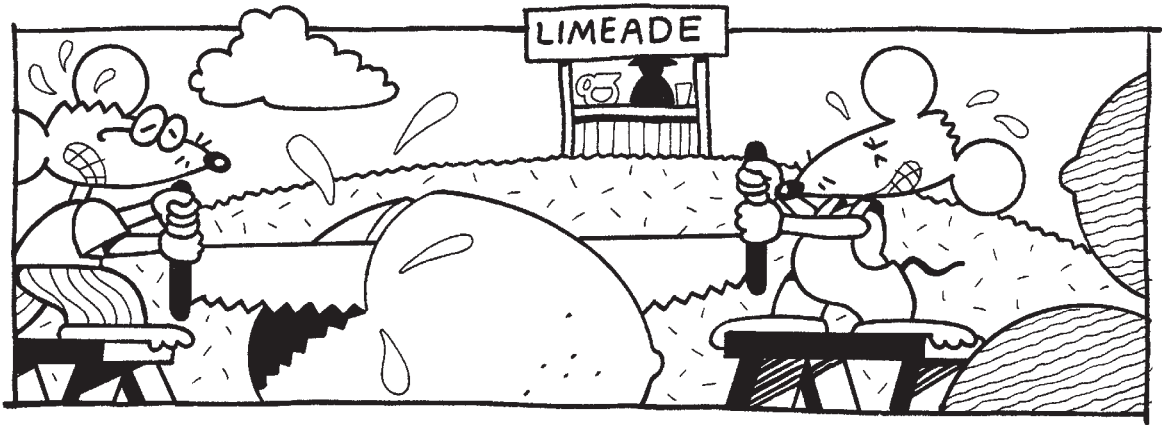




The boss and his wife said to pick ripe limes.

They picked from nine until nine.





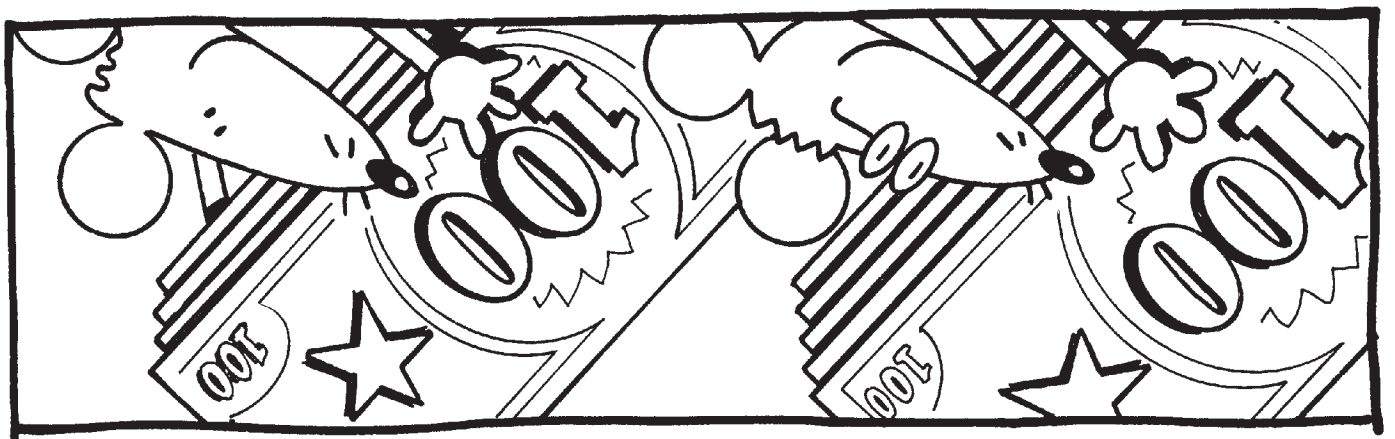
They helped the wife of the boss
make a fine lime drink.

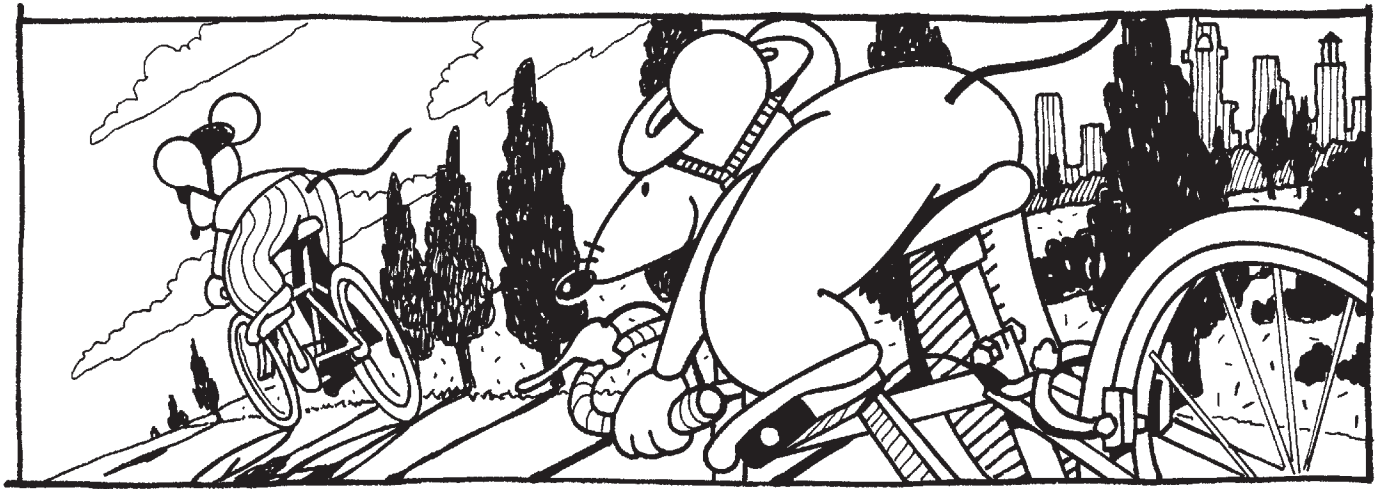
They sliced a pile of limes.
