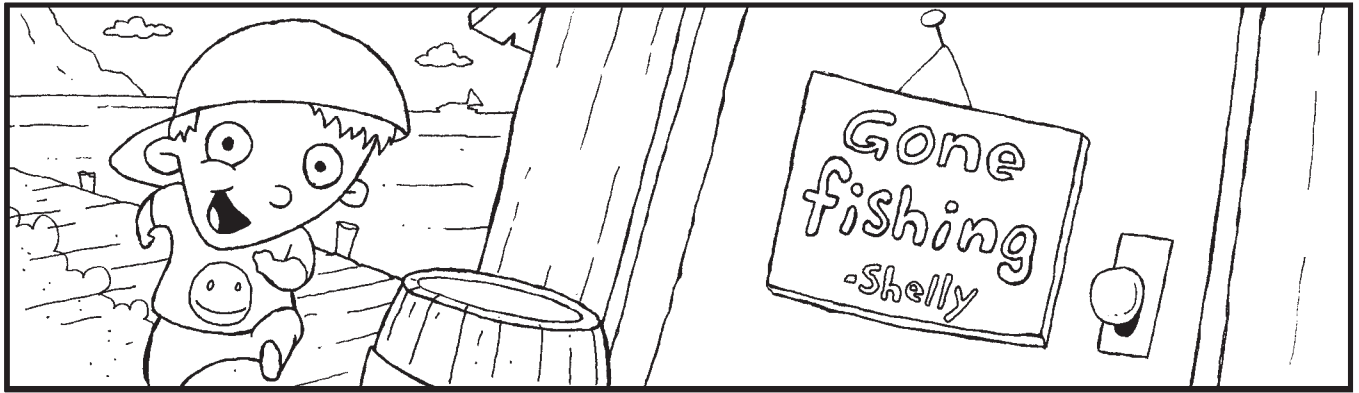
New phonic element sh digraph

He had lots of cash.

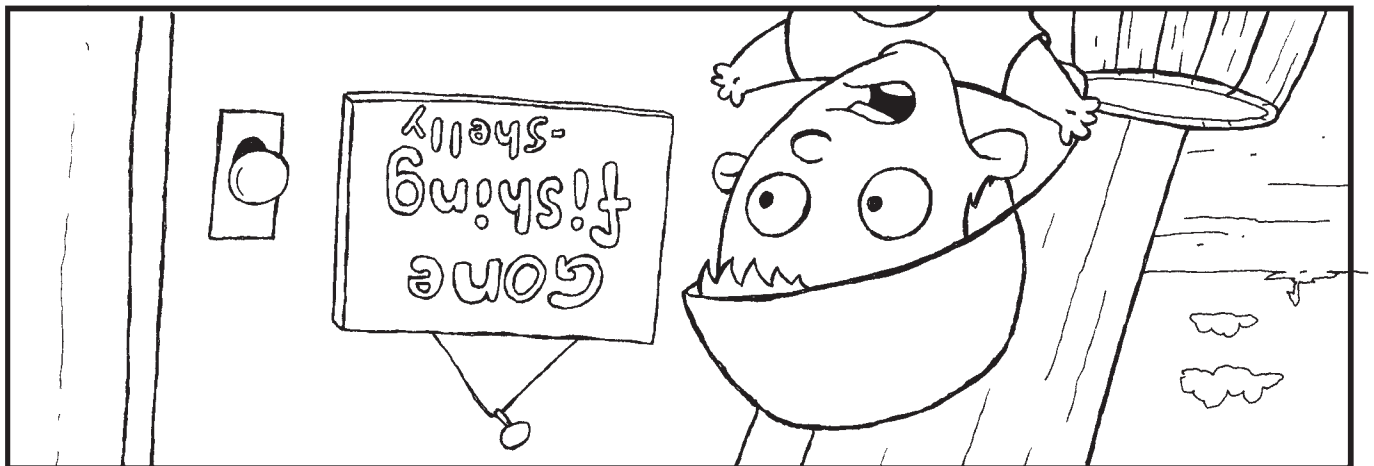




When Shane got to the shell shop,

to fish for shrimp.

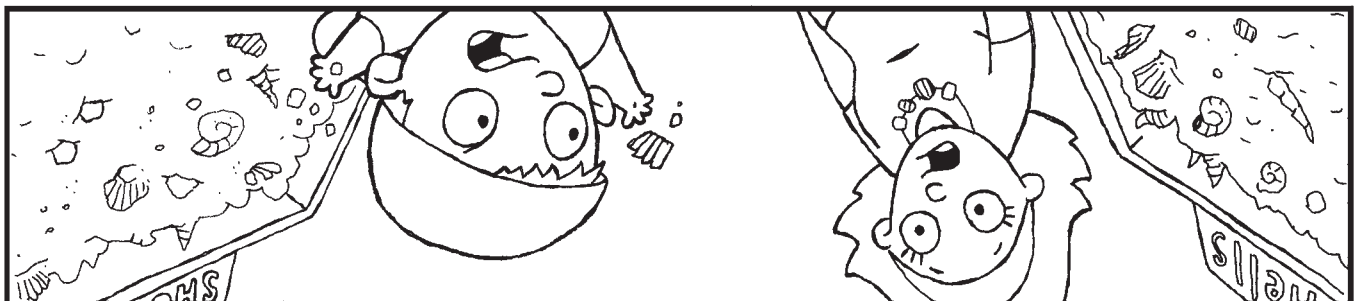
Shane was not happy.

shell shop to go fishing.

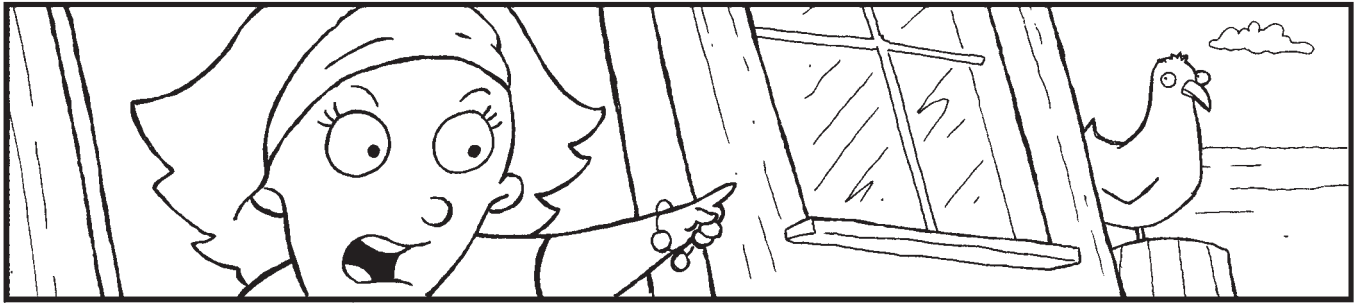




Shane dashed to the next shell shop.
