Reviewed phonic elements long vowel VCe patterns

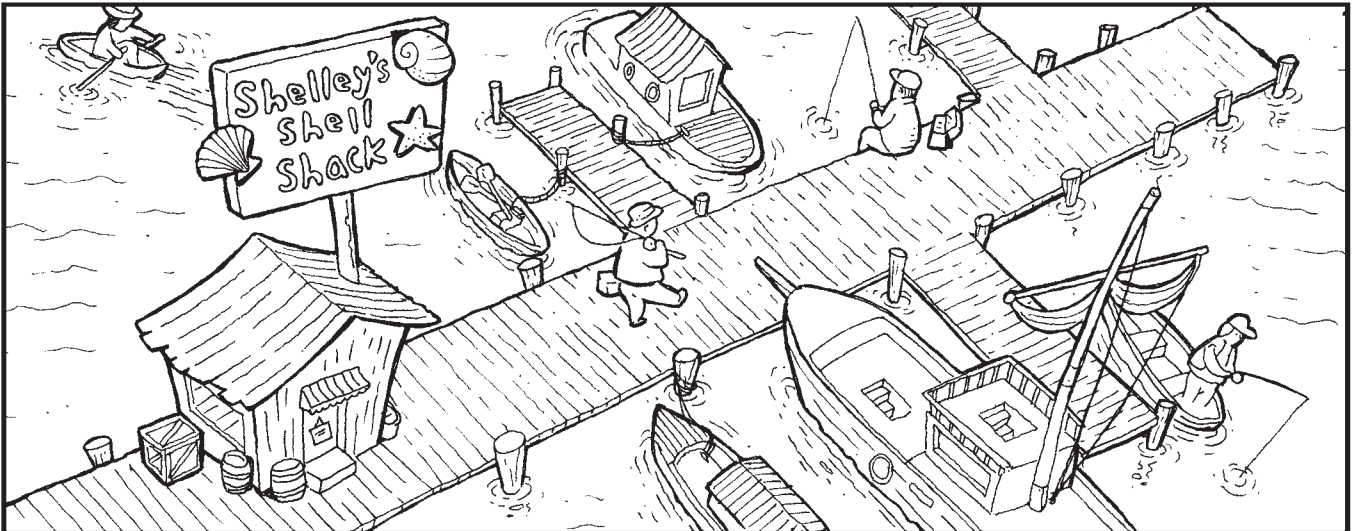
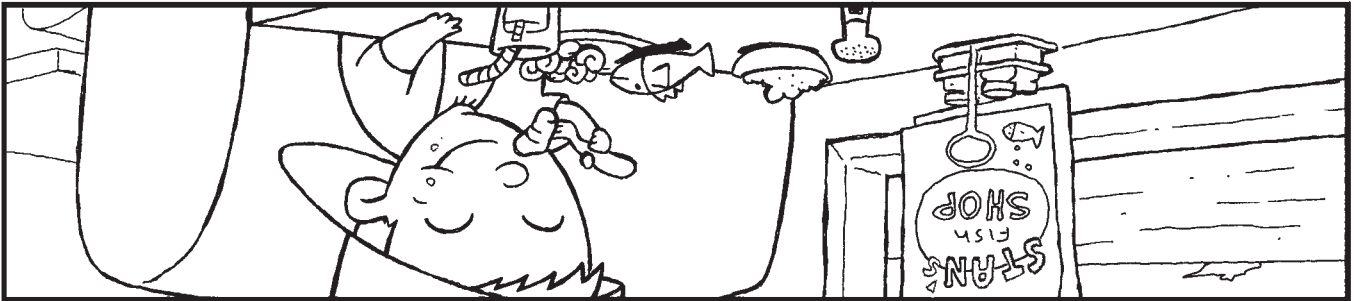
Story words *gone, Shelly, Shrek, shrimp*

New high-frequency words *next, than, these*

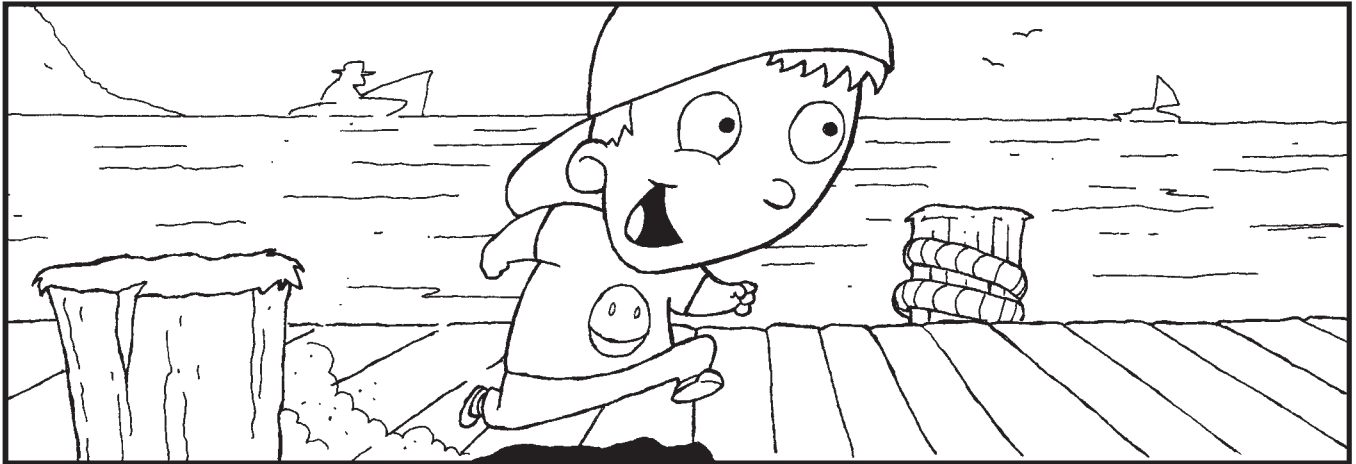
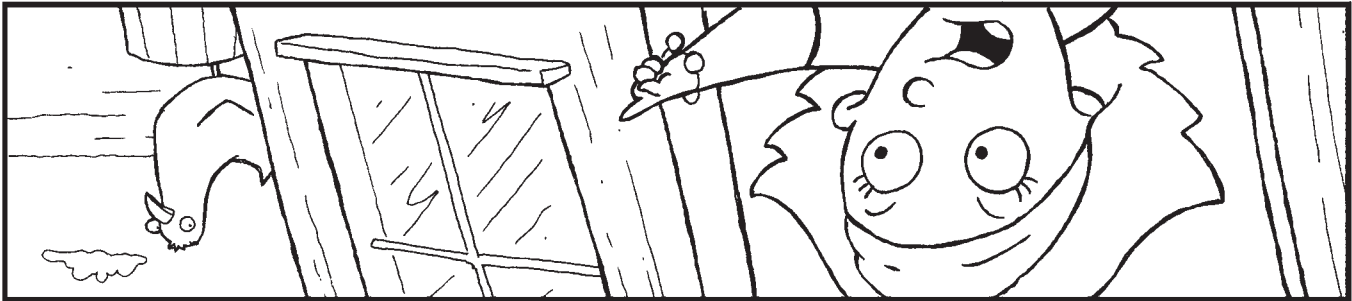
Special considerations inflectional endings *-ed,- ing, -s*;

 fresh fish and shrimp.



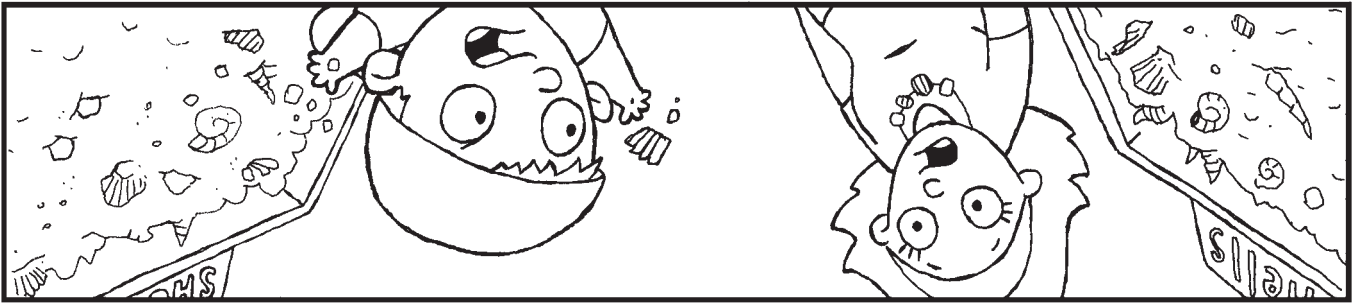
Shelly Shrek had a shell shop.
